June 1 - June 5

Week 1 - Discovering Me

Our Summer 2026 journey begins with a joyful exploration of identity, body awareness, and emotions. Through hands-on experiences with the parts of the body, the Five Senses, self-portraits, and name recognition, children will build vocabulary, coordination, confidence, and early literacy skills. As they learn to recognize and express their feelings, they will also strengthen self-awareness and a sense of belonging within our summer community.

Week 2 - My Family and My Home

During Week 2, children will explore the meaning of belonging through the theme My Family & My Home. As they learn about different kinds of families, family traditions, and the rooms in a home, they will build language, cultural awareness, and appreciation for the many ways we care for one another. Through meaningful practical life experiences such as organizing, cleaning, and caring for materials, children will also strengthen responsibility and discover how they contribute to their home and classroom community. This week encourages grace and courtesy, gratitude, respect, and a deep sense of connection and belonging.

Week 3 - My Community Helpers

During Week 3 of our Summer 2026 program, the children will explore the theme My Community Helpers, helping children understand the important roles of firefighters, doctors, teachers, farmers, and police officers. Through stories, discussions, and imaginative play, they will build gratitude, awareness, and a deeper sense of belonging within their community. In addition, the children will have a chance to meet real-life heroes and learn about fire safety in a fun, engaging way.

Week 4 - Nature Around Us

During Week 4 of our Summer 2026 program, the children will begin our July theme, Discovery of the World, by exploring Nature Around Us. They will learn about the parts of a plant, building vocabulary and a deeper understanding of how living things grow and function. Through gardening experiences, observing the butterfly life cycle, and taking nature walks to notice insects, plants, and seasonal changes, they will develop curiosity, responsibility, and a meaningful connection to the natural world. A visit to the Morton Arboretum will bring this learning to life through hands-on experiences and close encounters with nature along trails, gardens, and outdoor exhibits.

Week 5 - Discovering Of The World

During Week 5 of our Summer 2026 program, we will explore Around the World through culture and geography in a joyful, hands-on way. Children will use the Montessori globe to learn about land, water, and the continents, while also exploring flags, traditional clothing, and simple greetings in different languages. Through these experiences, they will build curiosity, respect for diversity, global awareness, and a sense of belonging to the larger human family.

Week 6 - Animals of The World

During Week 6 of our Summer 2026 program, we will continue our Discovery of the World theme by exploring Animals of the World. Children will learn about farm, jungle, and ocean animals, while discovering habitats, basic classification, and how animals adapt to their environments. During our in-house field trip the children will have a chance to gently interact with friendly animals making the experience both fun and memorable.



July 13 - July 17

Week 7 - Sun, Moon, and Stars

During Week 7 of our Summer 2026 program, we will continue our Discovery of the World theme by exploring Sun, Moon & Stars. Children will learn about day and night, sun safety, moon phases, and stars through simple observation and discussion. This week will spark wonder, imagination, and an early appreciation for the vast universe we are part of.

Week 8 - Caring for Our World

During Week 8 of our Summer 2026 program, we will focus on Caring for Our World, helping children develop a sense of responsibility, stewardship, and respect for their environment. Through activities such as recycling and sorting, saving water, showing kindness to animals, and learning how to be peaceful global citizens, children will discover that even small, thoughtful actions can make a meaningful difference. When we work together to care for our world, we help keep it clean, safe, and beautiful for everyone.

Week 9 - Weathers & Seasons

During the 9th and final week of our Summer Program, children will explore different types of weather, including sunny, rainy, snowy, and windy days, and learn how weather shapes the world around them. Through observing the sky, tracking temperature and weather changes, and discovering how plants, animals, and people adapt to the seasons, they will build curiosity, observation skills, and a deeper understanding of the natural world. The week will also include a fun in-house field trip hosted by Varsity Foam, where children will jump, play, and enjoy outdoor adventures in piles of bubbles, ending the summer with joy, movement, and excitement.

- Lunch for elementary is optional and is not included in the tuition fee. The fee is \$150/month or \$38/week.
- Before School Care: \$115/month or \$30/week; After School Care: \$210/month or \$53/week.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Late pick-up fee (after 5:00 pm) is \$1/minute.
- Tuition and lunch payments are due by the 5th of each month and will be charged through ACH on file.
- Tuition is processed monthly by the 5th of the month.
- Credit card payments are accepted with an additional 6% convenience fee.
- NO SCHOOL on June 19th and July 3rd.
- The last day of summer camp is July 31, 2026.
- In-house and outside field trips will be available at an additional cost for ALL programs.
